Dear Exhibitors:

In 1973, inspired by the old Indianapolis Junior League show of the 1950s, a group of central Indiana exhibitors launched a new competition at the Indiana State Fairgrounds, the Indy 500 Horse Show. Despite many challenges, the new event proved to be a rousing success.

Over the next decades, the renamed “Indianapolis Charity Horse Show” grew and flourished. Future world champions launched their campaigns at Indy – the road to Louisville ran through Indianapolis for many of the brightest stars of the show ring.

The 2023 Indianapolis Charity Show will continue that tradition of excellence with a new look at a new venue, the charming Hoosier Horse Park in Edinburg, Indiana. Join us this June for our “Party at the Park” as we celebrate 50 years of memories and make a few new ones – the best is yet to come!

Recognized as the site for the equestrian competition of the 1987 Pan American Games, the Hoosier Horse Park is set amid the pleasant and peaceful countryside of Johnson County Park, just off I-65, one hour north of Louisville and 30 minutes south of Indianapolis. Competition will take place in the Park’s bright and spacious Baker Arena which features a 125’ x 270’ indoor arena.

The roadster horse and Dutch Harness divisions make a welcome return this year (ADHHA qualifying show), plus we are excited to offer ASHBA National Select Series classes for the first time. As an ASHBA Star Show, points earned at Indianapolis Charity will count for the 2023 KSF World’s Championship Horse Show.

The venue may have changed but you can expect the same warm, Hoosier hospitality as always, this year featuring vendors, parties, food trucks and fun! Recreational activities are close by in Johnson County Park and surrounding area. Hotels, restaurants and shopping are located 11 minutes from the Park at the I-65/U.S.31 exit (Indiana Premium Outlets) and at the I-65/SR44 Franklin exit.

Stabling is limited so we encourage you to make hotel reservations and send entries early. We look forward to seeing you in Edinburg where we’ll make new memories for the next fifty years – the best is yet to come!

Rules & Regulations

The Indianapolis Charity Horse Show, Inc. reserves the right to its Show Committee the absolute and final right to interpret rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, differences, and questions regarding or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incident to the Show without claim, damages or recourse of any kind.

Arrival & Unloading

Horses will be admitted to the Hoosier Horse Park starting **at 8am, Tuesday, June 27**. Vans, trucks, trailers, and vehicles may not drive between barns. Please do not block roads. After unloading, empty trailers and vans must park in designated parking lot south of Barn K.

Out of State horses must have a health certificate signed by a licensed, accredited veterinarian within thirty days of exhibition. Horses must have a negative Coggins test within six months prior to unloading with the statement “Not from infected herd” (In lieu of statement on certificate, signature on entry blank by owner or agent will verify this statement “Not from infected herd”). It is highly recommended that horses be vaccinated for the Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) Vaccination but it is not a requirement. Copies sent with entries prior to arrival will facilitate unloading.

Stabling

Stabling at the Hoosier Horse Park consists of 10' x 12' permanent wood stalls on clay base with sliding doors in shed row barns, and 10' x 10' portable stalls on concrete floor with swing doors in Dunn Arena. Stabling will be limited. No first bedding will be provided. No entries will be accepted without payment for stalls.

All horses must depart by noon on Sunday July 2. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Use the same area for loading as unloading.

Stabling is limited—All Stalls are \$125.00 each.

Damage to any stalls will be charged and billed to the exhibitor responsible. Failure to make payment for damage will prohibit the exhibitor from making entries in the future to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.

Exhibitors will be expected to keep stalls clean and aisles swept down. The horse show management requests the cooperation of all exhibitors in keeping the facilities in “Show Shape”. All manure and debris must be placed in designated areas. Please put trash in trash barrels. Please help us keep our barns and grounds as clean as possible.

Bedding

No first bedding is provided. Bagged shavings will be available on the grounds at \$10 per bag. No straw permitted. **Pre-ordering bedding is strongly recommended and should be ordered on your entry blank. We must receive your bedding order by Friday, June 23, in order to have bags delivered to your stalls prior to arrival.** Shavings and hay will be available through the Show Office during the show.

Electrical Specifications

Only heavy-duty extension cords are allowed (no lightweight i.e. brown or white, etc cords are allowed). Only one piece of equipment is to be plugged into an extension cord. Extension cords are not to be run through the doorways, under floor coverings, or anywhere they might be damaged. Multiplug adapters are not allowed. Listed surge protectors/power tabs and over current protection are allowed. Surge protectors are not to be plugged together. Surge protectors are to be plugged directly into an outlet, not to be plugged into an extension cord. A minimum of 30" clearance must be maintained to ALL electrical panels located in the building. Any temporary wiring shall comply with the requirements of the Indiana Electrical Code.

Disputes/Protests

This show, through its show committee, reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding, or arising of, or incidents to the show without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. No dispute will be discussed while the show is in session.

A protest must be made in writing, signed and accompanied by a deposit of \$250.00. The deposit fee can be either a check, made payable to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show or cash. The protest must be received by a member of the Show Committee, the Show Manager or the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. If the protest is sustained the deposit fee shall be refunded. If the protest is not sustained the deposit fee shall be forfeited to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.

Disposal of Medical Waste

Sharps containers are provided by Show Management for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in the barns. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Liability

Every possible courtesy and protection will be extended to the exhibitors of the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show, Inc. but neither the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show Inc., its officers, or the Show Committee will be responsible for any article of any kind which may be lost, destroyed or stolen, nor will the Show Committee or the Show be responsible or liable in any way for injuries sustained in any manner to any persons, animals or property at the show or on the grounds nor will employees or agents of the management be held liable. Each exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the management from all claims as a condition of entry. The management reserves the right to remove any horse, caretaker, rider, driver, trainer, or any other person from the show grounds without being held liable for any compensation.

Footing/Show Ring

The footing in the work areas and in the show arena consists of a packed clay base with dirt used as the topping. The Baker Arena show ring is 125' x 270'. Warm up ring is 160' x 280'.

Veterinarian

The official Veterinarian is designated to make official inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of a veterinarian is required. In addition, they may be contacted through the Show Office if you need their services. **Veterinarian Office Number—Greg Bennett 317-730-1732**

Ringside Tables

There are a limited number of ringside tables available. The price for an eight seat ringside table is \$175.00.

RV Hookups

Camper and RV sites are within walking distance of stabling and include 30 Amp service and water for \$25.00 per night. Contact the Hoosier Horse Park office 812-526-6809 for reservations and payment.

Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash not exceeding six feet in length or confined to a stall. No dogs will be allowed to be tethered in the aisle. Dogs are not permitted in buildings or restrooms by order of State Board of Health.

Golf Carts, Motorcycles, Scooters

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or any farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Championship/Stake Classes

There is no post entry fee for stakes or championships. Exhibitors must pay the entry fees prior to the class, entry fees will not be deducted from the winnings. No qualification is required in Stake classes.

Premiums

Qualifying classes will be awarded trophy and 6 ribbons. Championships and stakes will be awarded a trophy and 8 ribbons.

Prize money will be mailed by check to the owner not later than 30 days following the conclusion of the show.

Watch for announcement of our “Trainer Bonus Bucks Incentive” for championships and stakes!

TBA Classes

TBA Classes - 50, 97, and 130 - can be purchased for \$200 each. Buyer selects class, subject to approval of the Show Committee. First come, first served. Added classes will not count toward qualification for KSF World Championship Horse Show.

Challenge/Memorial Trophies

Challenge, perpetual, and memorial trophies will be presented to the winners of the specific classes but will remain in the possession of the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.



Ring Procedure

Exhibitors are expected to have their entries ready when called. In classes in which horses compete collectively, the In Gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters Baker Arena. All entries must assemble in the make-up ring prior to their class and be checked in by the paddock announcer.

Entries

Entries close June 2, 2023. Post entries will be accepted at a one-time fee of \$30.00 per horse and must be made one hour before the session in which the horse will compete. There is no post entry fee for championships or stakes.

No entry will be accepted unless it is made on the regular printed form and payment made. No entry will be accepted unless it is made in writing and duly signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer and/or his/her agent, parent/guardian/trainer of a minor rider, driver or handler.

Horses and ponies must be shown under the ownership of record. Copies of registration papers must be submitted to the horse show office. If possible, please submit with the entries.

Entries must be accompanied by sufficient funds to cover entry, stall, and cataloging fees. A return check fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all checks returned due to insufficient funds. In all cases, the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" will not be accepted. The complete telephone and address of rider/driver/owner and trainer are required on the entry forms. **Please call if your entries are going to be late so we can plan accordingly. Stalls are limited – enter early.**

Exhibitors canceling entries in writing prior to the closing date of entries (June 2, 2023) shall be entitled to have all fees (except office fees) refunded. Any requests to withdraw horses after the closing date and prior to arrival on the grounds must be supported by a comprehensive diagnosis on a veterinarian certificate, the same to be forwarded to the show secretary before the show starts. All requests must be made in writing. Such a request will have 75% of all fees (except office fees) refunded. The show officially begins at 6:30pm Wednesday, June 28, 2023. No refunds allowed after the show begins.

No stall refunds after June 2 for any reason. No refunds for amounts less than \$50.00

No refunds allowed under any circumstances due to an act of God, cancellation of classes due to severe weather, other emergency or terrorism.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the relevant breed associations will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Create an account at Horse Shows Online. Create a record for each person and horse that you will use on the show entry forms when you enter the show.

Click “Enter Show” to select the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show and follow the steps in the wizard.

- Select the horses, people and riders for your entry.
- Select the classes each rider is to be entered in.
- Select the quantity of stalls and other fees.
- Confirm your selections.
- Checkout and submit your show entry.

The final steps generate the completed entry form and submits your entry to Indianapolis Charity Horse Show for review and acceptance. You will be prompted for your credit card information.

You can cancel your entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your “My Entries” tab and will allow you to edit the entry.



DIRECTIONS FROM INDIANAPOLIS

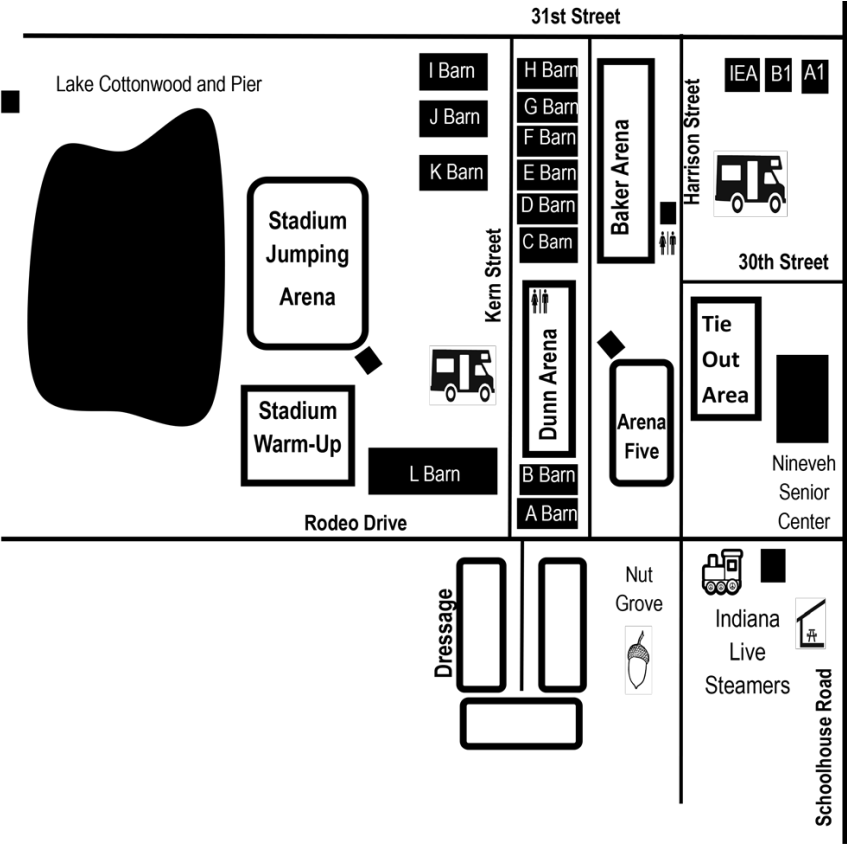
- Take I-65 South to Exit 90 (Franklin).
- Turn right off the exit to head WEST on SR 44 to US 31.
- Turn LEFT onto US 31 to go SOUTH. Stay on US 31S for five miles to SR 252.
- Turn RIGHT onto SR 252 to head WEST.
- Take SR 252 W two miles to County Road 325 E (Schoolhouse Road).
- Turn LEFT onto 325 E/Schoolhouse Road. Look for Johnson County Park sign.
- Hoosier Horse Park is located two miles SOUTH on Schoolhouse Road, past the Quarter Master on the right.

FROM LOUISVILLE

- Take I-65 NORTH to Exit 76-B (Edinburgh Outlet Mall).
- Turn RIGHT onto US 31 to go NORTH.
- Go to the third traffic light, and turn EAST (LEFT) at Hospital Road with a sign pointing toward Camp Atterbury.
- You will see Camp Atterbury, Johnson County Park and Hoosier Horse Park signs as you approach and pass the main gate to Atterbury.
- Turn at the first RIGHT onto Schoolhouse Road. You will pass the entrance to Atterbury Job Corps and look for the Hoosier Horse Park sign on left.

We do not recommend using GPS directions. They will typically take you to the wrong location.

Academy Division

The intent of the Academy Regional Show is to provide an atmosphere of FUN and ENJOYMENT at an entry level into the world of horse/rider competition.

Horses entered in the Academy **must** be those used as lesson horses in an academy program. Any breed horse may be entered in the Academy Regional Show but must be shown in English Tack (flat saddle and English bridle). Full bridles are optional. Snaffle bridles, single reins and martingales are permissible. No hunt/forward saddle may be used in the saddle seat classes.

Ages for academy are determined as of November 1, 2022. Riders 8 & under are not required to perform two diagonals. Instructors are permitted to stand in center ring during classes for any rider 10 & under.

Academy attire of white or colored shirt, riding pants/breeches/jeans and riding shoes/boots are required. Vests are optional. No riding habits are to be worn in the Academy Division. **ASTM Helmets are required for all academy riders under 18. Helmets are optional for riders 18 & over.**

Class Descriptions:

Pleasure—shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope; or walk & trot/jog. Judged on suitability as a pleasure type horse.

Equitation—shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope; or walk & trot/jog. Horsemanship only to count.

Classes are saddle seat unless otherwise noted.
