Dear Exhibitors:

In 1973, inspired by the old Indianapolis Junior League show of the 1950s, a group of central Indiana exhibitors launched a new competition at the Indiana State Fairgrounds, the Indy 500 Horse Show. Despite many challenges, the new event proved to be a rousing success.

Over the next decades, the renamed "Indianapolis Charity Horse Show" grew and flourished. Future world champions launched their campaigns at Indy – the road to Louisville ran through Indianapolis for many of the brightest stars of the show ring.

Indianapolis Charity continues that tradition with our second show at the beautiful Hoosier Horse Park in Edinburgh, Indiana. Exhibitors enthusiastically embraced our 2023 "Party at the Park, making our 50th Anniversary show a sold-out success!

Best known as the site for the equestrian competition of the 1987 Pan American Games, the Hoosier Horse Park is set amid the pleasant and peaceful countryside of Johnson County Park, just off I-65, one hour north of Louisville and 30 minutes south of Indianapolis. Competition will take place in the Park's bright and spacious Baker Arena which features a 125' x 270' indoor arena.

The ASHBA National Select Series makes a welcome return this year along with several new events: the Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge, the USTA Off Track Roadster class, a Hackney Pony Park Pleasure Driving Championship and an ADHHA Hunt Seat Pleasure division. We also remain an ADHHA qualifying show and an ASHBA Star Show. Points earned at Indianapolis Charity will count for the 2025 KSF World's Championship Horse Show.

The location may have changed but you can expect the same warm, Hoosier hospitality, this year featuring parties, food trucks and fun! Recreational activities are close by in Johnson County Park and surrounding area. Hotels, restaurants and shopping are located 11 minutes from the Park at the I-65/U.S.31 exit (Indiana Premium Outlets) and at the I-65/SR44 Franklin exit.

Stabling sold out in 2023 & 2024 so we encourage you to make hotel reservations and send entries early. We look forward to seeing you in Edinburgh this June!



Rules & Regulations

The Indianapolis Charity Horse Show, Inc. reserves the right to its Show Committee the absolute and final right to interpret rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, differences, and questions in regard to or otherwise airing out of, connected with, or incident to the Show without claim, damages or recourse of any kind.

Arrival & Unloading

Horses will be admitted to the Hoosier Horse Park starting at 8am, Tuesday, June 24, 2025. Vans, trucks, trailers, and vehicles may not drive between barns. Please do not block roads. After unloading, empty trailers and vans must park in designated parking lot south of Barn K.

Early Arrival: A fee of \$25 will apply to any stall utilized prior to 8am, Tuesday, June 24, 2025.

Out of State horses must have a health certificate signed by a licensed, accredited veterinarian within thirty days of exhibition. Horses must have a negative coggins test within six months prior to unloading with the statement "Not from infected herd" (In lieu of statement on certificate, signature on entry blank by owner or agent will verify this statement "Not from infected herd".) It is highly recommended that horses be vaccinated for the Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopheumonitis) Vaccination, but it is not a requirement. Copies sent with entries prior to arrival will facilitate unloading.

Stabling

Stabling at the Hoosier Horse Park consists of 10' x 12' permanent wood stalls on clay base with sliding doors in shed row barns. Stabling will be limited. No first bedding will be provided. No entries will be accepted without payment for stalls.

All horses must depart by noon on Sunday June 29, 2025. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Use the same area for loading as unloading.

Stabling is limited—All Stalls are \$155.00 each.

Damage to any stalls will be charged and billed to the exhibitor responsible. Failure to make payment for damage will prohibit the exhibitor from making entries in the future to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.

Exhibitors will be expected to keep stalls clean and aisles swept down. The horse show management requests the cooperation of all exhibitors in keeping the facilities in "Show Shape". All manure and debris must be placed in designated areas. Please put trash in trash barrels. Please help us keep our barns and grounds as clean as possible.

Bedding

Bag shavings will be available at \$12 per bag. In addition to ordering shavings on your entry blank, please text or call our show manager, Sandy Sessink at 248-207-4956 to give her your shavings count by Thursday, June 19th. To order additional shavings or hay throughout the show, please call or text Sandy. These orders will be run through the show office and added to your final bill. No need to go to the feed office, or the show office. Just call Sandy and your order will be delivered. Bedding on straw is not permitted.

NEW THIS YEAR: Pre-bedding is being offered at the rate of \$11 per stall. Just tell Sandy which stalls you want bedded and how many bags per stall, and your stalls will be bedded and ready upon your arrival at the show.

Electrical Specifications

Only heavy-duty extension cords are allowed (no light weight i.e. brown or white, etc. cords are allowed).

Only one piece of equipment is to be plugged into an extension cord. Extension cords are not to be run through the doorways, under floor coverings, or anywhere they might be damaged. Multi plug adapters are not allowed. Listed surge protectors/power tabs and over current protection are allowed. Surge protectors are not to be plugged together. Surge protectors are to be plugged directly into an outlet, not to be plugged into an extension cord. A minimum of 30" clearance must be maintained to ALL electrical panels located in the building. Any temporary wiring shall comply with the requirements of the Indiana Electrical Code.

Disputes/Protests

This show, through its show committee, reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising of, or incidents to the show without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. No dispute will be discussed while the show is in session.

A protest must be made in writing, signed and accompanied by a deposit of \$250.00. The deposit fee can be either a check, made payable to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show or cash. The protest must be received by a member of the Show Committee, the Show Manager or the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. If the protest is sustained the deposit fee shall be refunded. If the protest is not sustained the deposit fee shall be forfeited to the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.

Disposal of Medical Waste

Sharps containers are provided by Show Management for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in the barns.

Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Liability

Every possible courtesy and protection will be extended to the exhibitors of the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show, Inc. but neither the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show Inc., its officers, or the Show Committee will be responsible for any article of any kind which may be lost, destroyed or stolen, nor will the Show Committee or the Show be responsible or liable in any way for injuries sustained in any manner to any persons, animals or property at the show or on the grounds nor will employees or agents of the management be held liable. Each exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the management from all claims as a condition of entry. The management reserves the right to remove any horse, caretaker, rider, driver, trainer, or any other person from the show grounds without being held liable for any compensation.

Footing/Show Ring

The footing in the work areas and in the show arena consists of a packed clay base with dirt and river sand used as the topping. The Baker Arena show ring is 125'

x 270'. Warm up ring is 160' x 280'.

Ringside Tables

There are a limited number of ringside tables available. The price for an eight-seat ringside table is \$175.00.

RV Hookups

Camper and RV sites are within walking distance of stabling and include 30 mp service and water for \$25.00 per night. Contact the Hoosier Horse Park office 812-526-6809 for reservations and payment

Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash not exceeding six feet in length or confined to a stall. No dogs will be allowed to be tethered in the aisle. Dogs are not permitted in buildings or restrooms by order of State Board of Health

Golf Carts, Motorcycles, Scooters

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or any farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds.

Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Championship/Stake Classes

There is no post entry fee for stakes or championships. Exhibitors must pay the entry fees prior to the class; entry fees will not be deducted from the winnings. Stake classes do not require a qualifier to enter. Half-Saddlebreds are not eligible for ASB Stakes.

Premiums

Qualifying classes will be awarded trophy and 6 ribbons. Championships and stakes will be awarded a trophy and 8 ribbons.

Prize money will be mailed by check to the owner not later than 30 days following the conclusion of the show.

Masters

SB 103 -14. Master classes are restricted to amateur rider/drivers age 60 years and older. Classes are to be judged according to amateur class specifications. Master classes are never to be stripped for con-formation judging. BOD 06/17/24 Effective 12/01/24

TBA Classes

TBA Classes – 10.1, 55.1, and 78.1 - can be purchased for \$200 each. Buyer selects class, subject to approval of the Show Committee. First come first served. Added classes will not count toward qualification for KSF World Championship Horse Show.

Challenge/Memorial Trophies

Challenge, perpetual, and memorial trophies will be presented to the winners of the specific classes but will remain in the possession of the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show.

Ring Procedure

Exhibitors are expected to have their entries ready when called. In classes in which horses compete collectively, the In Gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters Baker Arena. All entries must assemble in the make-up ring prior to their class and be checked in by the paddock announcer.



Academy Division

UPHA CHAPTER 11 ACADEMY CLUB CLASSES & RULES

Academy classes are open to any rider presently enrolled in a professionally operated riding lesson program. Riders must be mounted on school horses. Horses in academy classes may be owned by anyone but they cannot be in training and they MUST currently earn their living in a professionally managed riding lesson pro-gram. Riders may show their own horses in academy provided the horse is regularly used in a professional lesson program. Academy horses may be shown by non-academy riders in any other classes in the show for which they are eligible.

"Show Riders" may participate in Academy classes on school horses in the advanced divisions. A "show" rid-er is one who has shown in non-academy classes at an open or breed horse show, not including 4-H, where according to USEF guidelines, riding suits/proper attire is required to show. Once a rider has shown in any walk/trot/canter class, that rider may no longer compete in walk and trot classes. Age of academy riders shall be determined as of November 1, 2024.

Rider Appointments: All riders 17 years of age and under are required to wear a helmet. No full riding suits allowed. Long sleeve shirts and appropriate riding pants, breeches or jods with suitable riding boots for each discipline are to be worn – gloves, ties and vests are optional. Chaps and sweatshirts are prohibited.

Horse Appointments: Saddle and bridles shall be appropriate for the particular discipline being judged. Work bridles and martingales are allowed. Double bridles in saddle seat are optional. No braids or braiding allowed. Hooves may be blacked or polished. Horses are not to be gingered. Pads on shoes are optional.

Judging: Academy equitation classes shall be judged on basic equitation skills: rider form, ability to execute correct leads and diagonals and ability to control and show their horse to its best advantage. Pleasure clas-ses shall be judged on the rider's horsemanship skills and their ability to show their mount to best advantage and manage the show ring. Leads and diagonals shall count. Horses will NOT be judged.

Beginner Walk & Trot: Riders in their first seasons of showing walk and trot academy other than lead line or walk and trot on the lead.

Intermediate Walk & Trot: Riders in their third season or more in walk and trot who have never shown in a canter class.

Intermediate Walk/Trot/Canter: Riders in their first seasons of showing at the canter.

Advanced Walk/Trot/Canter: Show riders or riders who have shown for four or more seasons in walk/trot/canter academy.

Pattern Classes: Open to all ages and all seats. Entry fees from both pattern classes will be donated to IASHA Youth Club.

Entries

Entries close June 10, 2025. Post entries will be accepted at a onetime fee of \$30.00 per horse and must be made one hour before the session in which the horse will compete. There is no post entry fee for championships or stakes.

No entry will be accepted unless it is made on the regular printed form and payment made. No entry will be accepted unless it is made in writing and duly signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer and/or his/her agent, parent/guardian/trainer of a minor rider, driver or handler.

Horses and ponies must be shown under the ownership of record. Copies of registration papers must be submitted to the horse show office. If possible, please submit with the entries.

Entries must be accompanied by sufficient funds to cover entry, stall, and cataloging fees. A return check fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all checks returned due to insufficient funds. In all cases, the description on the entry blank must full identify the horse. The word "entry" will not be accepted. The complete telephone and address of rider/driver/owner and trainer are required on the entry forms. **Please call if**

your entries are going to be late so we can plan accordingly. Stalls are limited and were sold out in 2023 & 2024 – enter early.

Exhibitors canceling entries in writing prior to the closing date of entries (June 10, 2025) shall be entitled to have all fees (except office fees) refunded. Any requests to withdraw horses after the closing date and prior to arrival on the grounds must be supported by a comprehensive diagnosis on a veterinarian certificate, the same to be forwarded to the show secretary before the show starts. All requests must be made in writing. Such a request will have 75% of entry fees (except office fees) refunded. The show officially begins at 6:30pm Wednesday, June 25, 2025. No refunds allowed after the show begins.

No stall refunds after June 10 for any reason. No refunds for amounts less than \$50.00

No refunds allowed under any circumstances due to an act of God, cancellation of classes due to severe weather, other emergency or terrorism.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the relevant breed associations will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Create an account at Horse Shows Online. Create a record for each person and horse that you will use on the show entry forms when you enter the show.

Click "Enter Show" to select the Indianapolis Charity Horse Show and follow the steps in the wizard.

- Select the horses, people and riders for your entry.
- Select the classes each rider is to be entered in.
- Select the quantity of stalls and other fees.
- Confirm your selections.
- Checkout and submit your show entry.

The final steps generate the completed entry form and submits your entry to Indianapolis Charity Horse Show for review and acceptance. You will be prompted for your credit card information.

You can cancel your entry part way through the wizard and resume the entry later. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My Entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry.

By entering and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the rules of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Show Committee on any question arising under the rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition or sport. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of the rules are governed by the laws of the State of Indiana and any action instituted against the competition must be filed in the state of Indiana.

Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in the Competition Indianapolis Charity Horse Show to the following:

I AGREE that the "Competition" as used herein includes the Show Committee, Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations, the American Saddlebred Horse Association, Indiana American Saddlebred Horse Association and the C Bar C Expo.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. - A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of the IASHA Spring Warm-Up Horse Show as published in the IASHA Spring Warm-Up Horse Show premium book and as posted and as amended from time to time.




FROM LOUISVILLE
